



FAIR DETAILS



Booths will be spread out throughout the lower level of the mall.



Booth assignment is randomized. Students pick from a basket.



A booth will consist of a 6 ft table and 2 chairs. These will be provided.



Decorations should be on the table. No guarantees you will have space next to the table for extra racks or signs.



No electricity will be provided to any booth, and the mall does not allow external power sources



Little CEOs have to run their business and sell their products on their own. No parental help for operations!

FOOD BUSINESS RULES

Loudoun CBF will obtain a Temporary Food Vendor permit from the Virginia Department of Health

Food should not be placed on the floor, and should be kept beneath the pavilion roof


Food cannot be prepared at the fair – it must be prepared and pre-packaged at home

All food should be individually packaged and marked with prep date

Keep food covered at all times within individual wrappers or in containers

Proper temperature should be maintained for hot and cold foods


Maintain hygiene at booth while displaying and serving






Kids in the program will get to learn cool tips from real business experts and other kidpreneurs.




